



The University of Mount Union is pleased to announce we will once again offer online courses through our course sharing consortium, Acadeum, this Summer 2024 and Fall 2024. Using this consortium, you can grab a few extra credits or repeat a course to replace a low grade.

This opportunity reflects our commitment to ensuring you have access to the courses you need to make progress when we don't have them readily available at Mount Union.

If you are interested in taking an online course through Acadeum, please stop into the Office of the University Registrar to learn more or login with your student email address to request a course **HERE**. These pre-approved courses are made available via Acadeum, from another institution, will count toward your degree*, can be taken as repeat for change of grade, and will appear on your transcript as a Mount Union course.

*There are some restrictions. Please check with your Department Chair, School Director, or the University Registrar if you are unsure.

A Few Important Notes about online shared courses through Acadeum:

- More than 500 Approved Courses!
- **Tuition Cost:** \$475 per credit hour (based on the credits assigned for the UMU equivalent). Please note Acadeum courses are NOT included in your Mount Union tuition and will be charged additional to your billing statement each semester.
- **How to Register:** Register at www.acadeum.com
- **Financial Aid:** Please contact the Office of Student Financial Aid (<u>finaid@mountunion.edu</u>) or the Business Office (<u>billing@mountunion.edu</u>) to determine if you are eligible to use financial aid.
- **Billing:** Students on a current hold are not permitted to register for Acadeum courses. Charges for Acadeum courses must be paid prior to the start of the course and are not part of your regular semester tuition. Full time registration in Spring is required to qualify for Acadeum approval.
- **How Will the Course Appear:** Acadeum courses will appear on your schedule and transcript as Mount Union courses.
