



**Spring 2016 UMU & Partner Collaboration Programs
P-12 Student Feedback Survey Results**

In the Spring 2016, three partnerships were established that involved UMU candidates from various program areas and 83 P-12 students in grades 3, 4, and 5. Partnerships included Lexington Elementary School, Rockhill Elementary School (RAC: Raider Aviator Connection), and Luiz Muñoz Marin Elementary School. After participating in collaborative projects and field experiences, P-12 students completed a survey to determine impact of the programs. Results from the survey are below. Overall, P-12 students found the programs to be successful and believe they should continue in future semesters.
