

2017 UMU & Partner Collaboration Programs P-12 Student Feedback Survey Results

In the Fall 2017, two partnerships were continued that involved UMU candidates from various program areas and 76 P-12 students in grades 3, 4, and 5. Partnerships included Rockhill Elementary School (N=25 P-12 students) and Orchard STEM School (N=51 P-12 students). After participating in collaborative projects and field experiences, P-12 students completed a survey to determine impact of the programs. Results from the survey are below.
