



## 2015 – 2017 P-12 Family Feedback Survey Results

As part of the ECH200 and/or EDU234 courses, Teacher Candidates design and host a theme-based Family Learning Night for a local elementary school. The planned activities must align with standards, be engaging and developmentally appropriate, and promote families’ understanding of grade level learning targets. Goals of the activity are for Teacher Candidates to benefit from opportunities to interact with families, children to benefit from the reinforcing practice activities, families to benefit from the opportunity to see their children engage in learning activities, and partnership schools to benefit from the opportunity to informally interact with families throughout the night.

An exit survey is completed to gain impact data and gather information to guide future endeavors. Collected data is represented below. Overall, families found the programs to be successful and believe they should continue.
