## What Items Should I Buy during Orientation Week?

## **Necessities**

- Bed linens twin XL (extra long) size (mattresses are 80 inches (203.2 cm) in length)
- · Towels and washcloths
- · Bathrobe
- · Bucket or some sort of carrier to hold your bathroom items
- Sandals or slippers (to walk to the bathroom and for showers)
- Personal items (soap, mirror, toiletries, etc.)
- · Laundry detergent/dryer sheets and laundry basket/bag
- Iron (ironing boards are available in some residence halls)
- Hangers for clothes
- Basic kitchen needs (silverware, manual can opener, plate, bowl, cup, microwave-able dish, dish towel, dish soap)
- Basic cleaning needs (cleaner, paper towels, etc.)
- Kleenex
- Desk lamp/study lamp
- School supplies (paper, pens, scissors, tape, stapler, notebooks)
- First aid items (bandages, aspirin and any necessary medications)
- Umbrella and rain gear
- Strong key chain (Čollege Bookstores have key chains with ID holders which are ideal)
- Flashlight
- Power strip/surge protector

## **Optional Items**

- Refrigerator (no larger than 4.0 cubic ft.)
- Stereo/radio
- Television/DVD
- Small microwave
- Computer
- Fan
- Camera
- Bicycle and bicycle lock
- Carpeting or rugs for your floor
- Coffee makers
- Storage containers
- Sports equipment and various games (board games, cards, etc.)
- Dry erase board for room door
- Small sewing kit
- Posters/pictures
- Room decorating items (plants, storage boxes, shelves, etc.)

## Prohibited Items—Do Not Bring to College!

Due to fire safety and other concerns, the following items are prohibited from traditional residence hall rooms:

- · Air conditioners
- · Bread machines
- Candles (decorative or otherwise)
- Deep fryers
- Electric grills

- Electric frying pans
- Firearms or other weapons
- Firecrackers
- Any flammable decorations made of cotton batting, straw, vines, leaves, shrubbery or foam plastic
  • Halogen lamps
  • Hot dog cookers

- Hot plates
- Hot pots for water
- Incense
- Live Christmas trees
- Oil based popcorn poppers
- Oil burners
- Pets (other than fish)
- Pine roping or garlandPotpourri cookers
- Refrigerators larger than 4.0 cubic ft.
- Rice cookers
- Slow cookers / crock pots
- Space heaters
- Sun lamps
- Toaster ovens / toasters
- Waterbeds
- Woks (electric)
